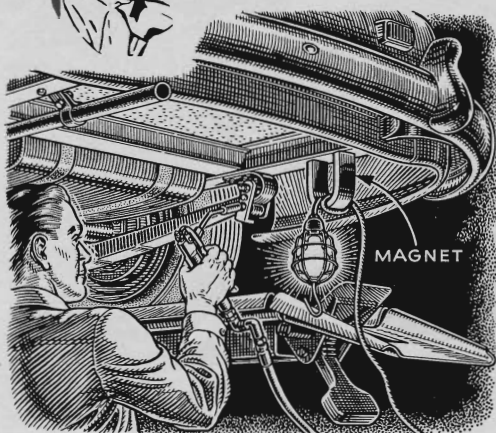
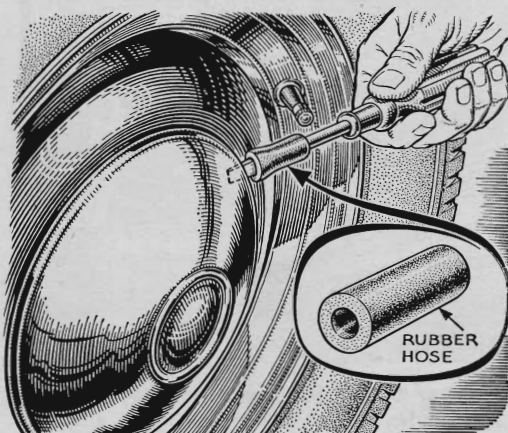




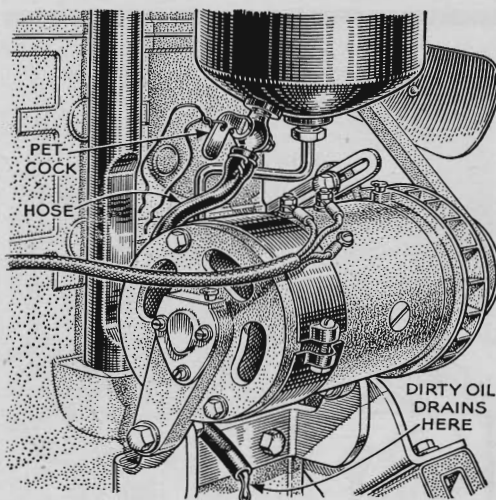
Hints from the Model Garage



Magnet Supports Light. By looping an extension cord around a large horseshoe magnet, you can place a light exactly where you want it while working under a car. It's handy in places where the hook support doesn't spot the light where you need it.



Rubber Prevents Paint Scratches. A short piece of rubber hose slipped over your screwdriver will protect wheel finish when you're removing hub caps. Slip the tip under the cap and slide down the hose as far as possible before you pry.



Hose Drains Oil Filter. Many oil filters have a plug at the base for draining out sludge and dirt. If the drainings would fall on engine accessories below, install a petcock like this and run a synthetic-rubber hose down far enough so the dirty oil will drop clear. Drill a hole in the petcock handle and use a wire to "safety" it.



Fire Clears Stubborn Screens. Your oil-pump screen should be cleaned occasionally, even if you must drop the pan specifically for the purpose. If brush and gasoline won't do the job, put a match to the screen, let the sludge burn, and brush away the ash. This won't damage a screen unless it's soldered together.
