


Small battery drains can be checked by connecting an ignition coil in series between the battery post and its cable. Ground the highvoltage wire from the coil and watch for arcs. Move the wiring harness around until you have located the faulty circuitry.



When inserting the armature on a generator or starter motor, here's a simple tool for holding the brushes out of the way. Form a spring-steel clip into the shape of a hairpin, with a hook at each end. Use it to hold the brush "pigtails" close to the casing.



Transmission air vents on '63 Fairlanes can get clogged up on dirt roads-especially when muddy. The solution is an air-vent extension of 1/4-inch i.d. rubber hose, running up to a hook on the firewall, with open end turned down to keep foreign matter out.
